- 3. The Scholastics are open to all students who meet the age and attendance requirements (see below for principal's declaration).
- 4. Participants must be worthy ambassadors of their region and their country should they be selected to represent New Zealand or attend other international events.
- 5. <u>Smoking, taking drugs and the consumption of alcohol</u> at national competitions is not acceptable and may result in the participant being disqualified.

CONTEST FORMAT AND RULES
